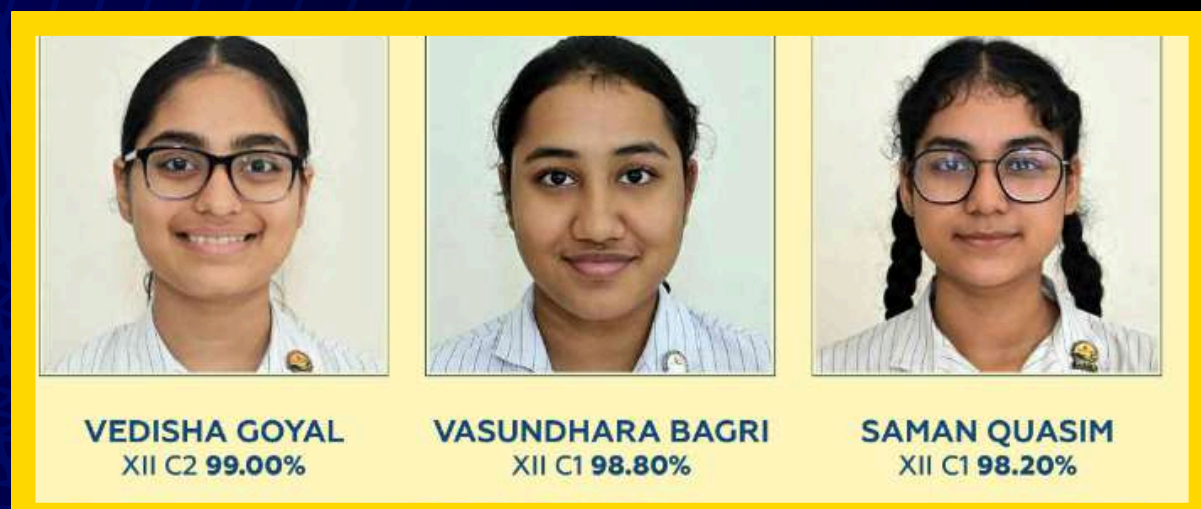
RAM AVTAR GUPTA HINDI PROTSAHAN AWARDS 2024
